50% less fatalities on TERN

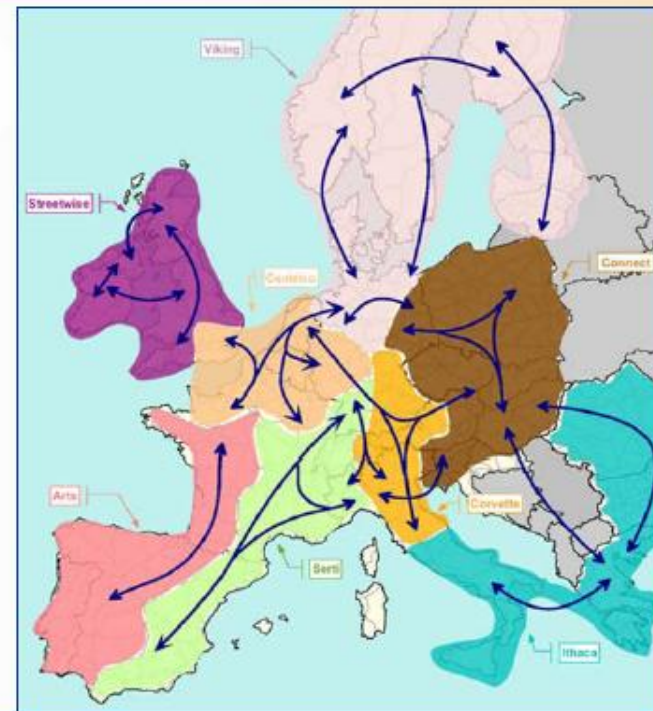
10% less CO-2 emissions

What is the EasyWay Geographic Area?



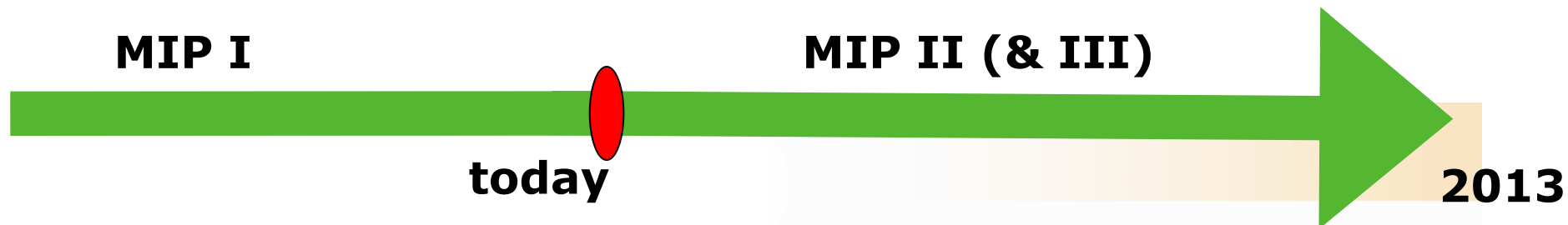
ESG = European Expert and Study Group in the EasyWay Framework

How does EasyWay work:

- Produce Revise and promote **Deployment Guidelines** according to Member State and stakeholder requirements
- Deploy and monitor harmonised services across Europe according to agreed Deployment Guidelines
- Develop cooperation with external stakeholders on Viability Studies, with the aim to set up new Deployment Guidelines, or supporting actions

EasyWay is structured into Euro-Regions, each concerned with cross-border issues below the pan-European Scale

EasyWay started in 2007 and in 2010 will start its second phase



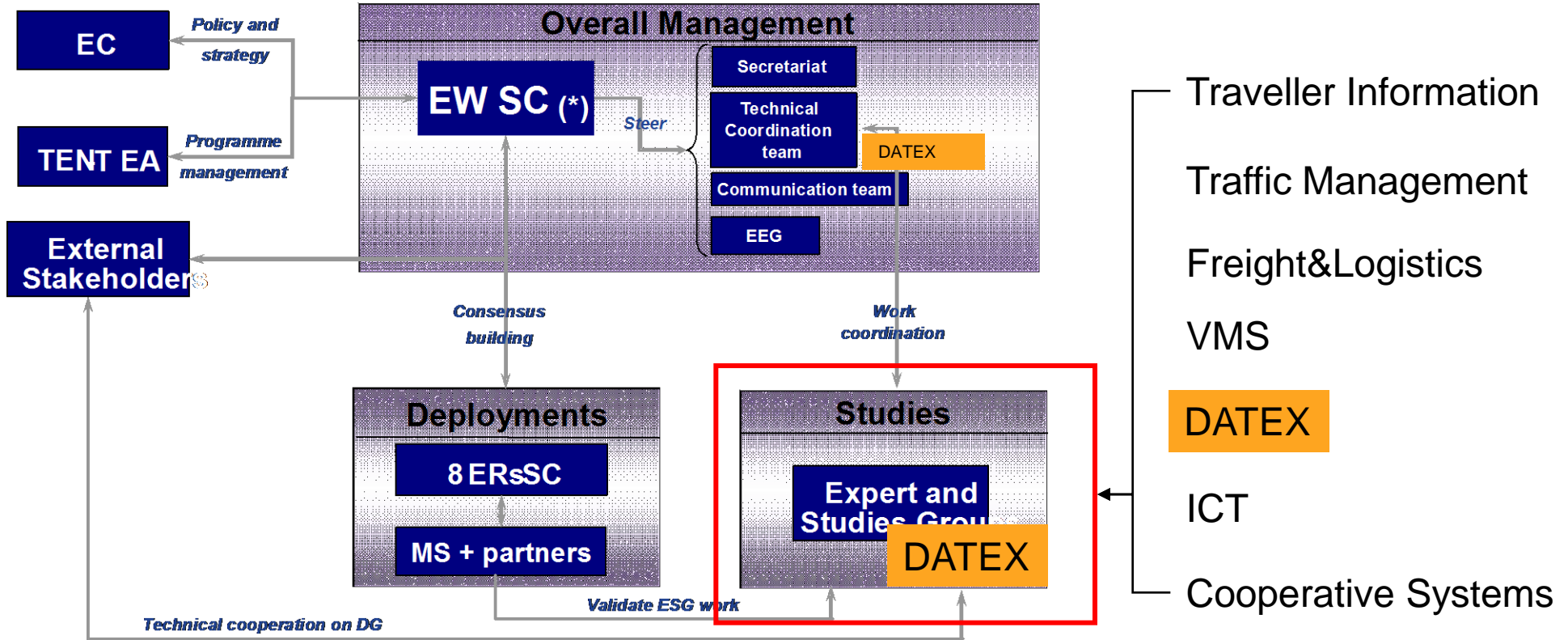
Developed Deployment Guidelines (DG) for most relevant ITS Services

DG are in place and validated by the Member States

ES 5 DATEX Started in 2008

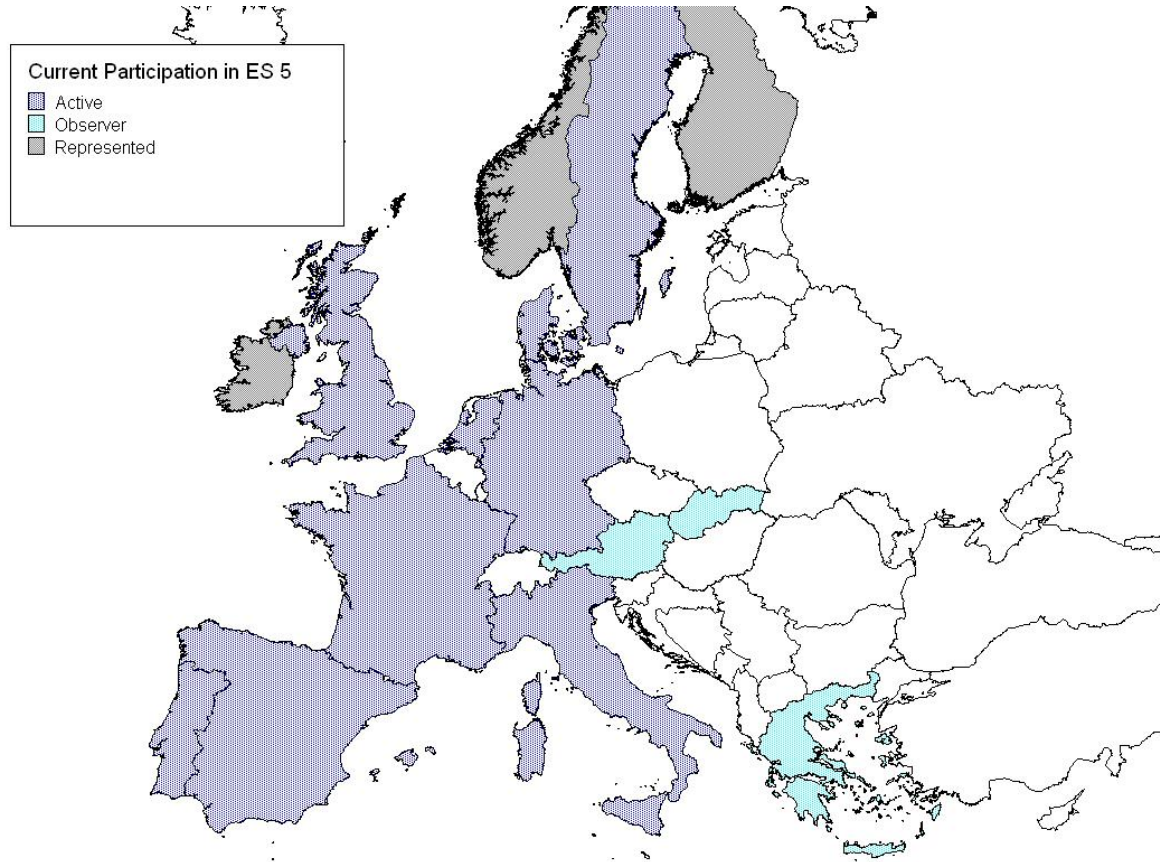

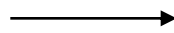

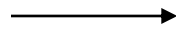
